ACHILLEA

APPLE BLOSSOM

YARROW

Medium pink, about 24” tall when blooming and 8” tall grey-green foliage from spring to late fall, Achillea, or yarrow, provides large composite blooms that are the perfect “landing pads” for butterflies and other beneficial insects.

Best suited for full sun, Achillea will tolerate drought, heavy snowfall and neglect with easy grace. The perfect planting for hillsides where nothing else grows well.

cimicifuga/bugbane

At home in full shade, Actea can tolerate part /dappled shade. Ferny foliage rises as high as 4' throughout the year with varieties ranging from pale green to deep purple.

In the late fall, Actea finishes with a bang, 12"-18" racemes of white or pink flowers droop gracefully. Resistant to insects, Actea's leaves go through the year uneaten.

This plant can clump to easily 4' across, a welcome presence in a shade garden. Atropurpurea, with its deep purple leaves, gives texture and structure as well as color to your shade garden.

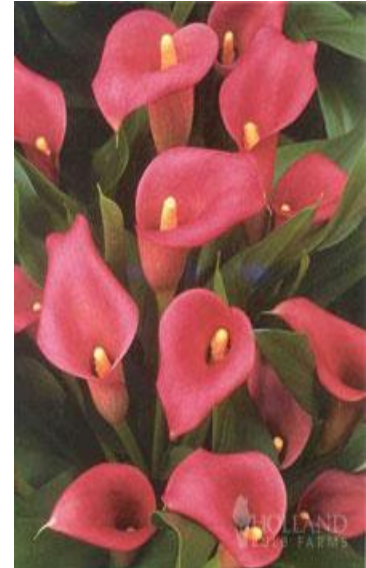
